Golden Valley Chorus (GVC) ~ 25 male singers featured Chorus, opening Act I, Closing Act II

Dan Warschauer (MC) Show Emcee at Podium Stage Right

Four for the Road Quartet (4FTR) Male Quartet performing with GVC during Act I in front of OPEN MAIN.

The Velvet Frogs Men's Quartet (VF) Male Quartet performing up to the closing of Act I.

ARTISTIC LICENSE (AL) Headliner Male Quartet performing in Act II.

Lexi Anderson (LA) Female Dancer performing with GVC during Act II in front of OPEN MAIN.

MICROPHONES

Mic 1 [VOG] is backstage right speaking mic on a stand for VOG at show open and emergency prov by Theater (SM58 or equivalent)

Mic 2 [MC] is a downstage right speaking mic at a podium, provided by Theater (SM58 or equivalent)

Mics 3 & 4 [QTET] are a paired set, downstage center, for quartet, **provided by GVC (SM-81)**

Mics 5 & 6 [[SR]/SL] are two wireless handhelds on mic stands for soloists. Location variable, but basically downstage SR and SL.

Mics 7, 8, 9 [CHORUS] are 3 hanging microphones, set above and in front of choral risers

One Pair provided by Theater Sennheiser MD-421U **Additional** provided by GVC as needed CAD 95s

Mic 10 [FLO] is Wireless Mic (**provided by GVC**) for Actress Florine Smith on stage with GVC in ACT 1.

STAGE SET

Stage will be set with 5 sets of 3-step choral risers centered on stage about 3 feet upstage of main curtain.

VF and AL quartets perform downstage of closed main, at center mics.

4FTR quartet will sing while chorus on stage, with main open.

LIGHTING

Full chorus wash [**WASH**] (adjustable)

Primary Director Special used for chorus fades (hang from 2nd electric, soft edge focus, can be on when chorus wash is on)

CHORUS WASH TO 30% WHEN SPEAKING AT [SR] MICS (emcee work), [unless noted]

19° ellipsoidal curtain warmer, focused on grand drape ~~with gobo~~ [**GOBO**]

Pools for downstage center mics for quartets and at stage right podium and mic for emcee

Bow Lights for quartets – slightly wider than center pool

Two Follow spots on DANCER (LA) for 2nd song in GVC Set ACT II "The Water is Wide"

IN GENERAL, run fades at 5 sec, **UNLESS NOTED** and work lights for back stage when MAIN closed = **2nd ELEC 20%**

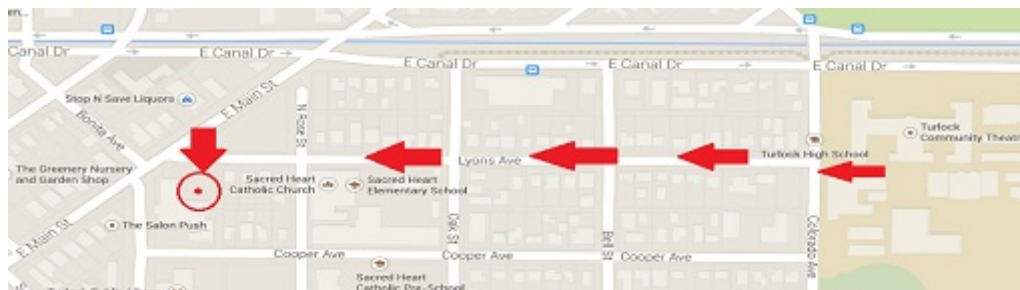
